Dear Secretary Mayorkas:

We write to you regarding the April 1, 2022 announcement by the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) to terminate its order under Title 42 to suspend the entry of migrants into the United States. Title 42 is the strongest tool available to deter illegal immigration into our country and keep our borders secure during the COVID-19 pandemic. Our U.S. Customs and Border Protection (CBP) agents and officers are already overwhelmed, and this decision will only exacerbate the current crisis.

Since its implementation in March 2020, Department of Homeland Security (DHS) has expelled more than 1.7 million migrants under Title 42, and just last month over 55 percent of migrants encountered along the southwest border were expelled.¹ It has been reported that your department is preparing to encounter upwards of 18,000 migrants crossing per day.² Additionally, reports indicate that between 30,000 and 60,000 migrants are already waiting in Mexico to cross.³

As you know, this planned termination will be implemented beginning on May 23, 2022, and will have massive implication for DHS and our CBP agents and officers. We write to request information on how DHS plans to secure the border in light of the lifting of Title 42 expulsion authorities. We have reviewed your fact sheet on the Departments preparations for increased migration but do not believe it adequately provides information in light of the ongoing COVID-19 pandemic. Therefore, we request answers to the following questions, in writing, by May 1, 2022:

- 1. How does DHS plan to screen migrants for COVID-19 and other communicable diseases? What is the departments testing capacity?
- 2. Will a quarantine period be required for unvaccinated migrants? If so, where will they be quarantined?
- 3. Will vaccinations be administered to all migrants for COVID-19? If so, will these vaccinations be voluntary?

- 4. What will the department do with migrants who test positive for COVID-19? How will DHS officers and agents be protected from COVID-19 positive migrants?
- 5. Under what circumstances will you request resources and additional personnel from other U.S. government agencies?
