To authorize appropriations to carry out payments with respect to qualified losses of covered crops occurring in calendar year 2022, and for other purposes.
1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
4 This Act may be cited as the "The Emergency Relief
5 Program Reauthorization Act of 2022".

1	SEC. 2. QUALIFIED LOSSES OF COVERED CROPS OCCUR-
2	RING IN CALENDAR YEAR 2022.
3	(a) In General.—The Secretary shall carry out a
4	program to make payments for necessary expenses related
5	to qualified losses of covered crops occurring in calendar
6	year 2022 in accordance with subsection (b).
7	(b) Administration of Payments.—
8	(1) In general.—Except as provided in para-
9	graph (2), payments to producers for qualified losses
10	of covered crops under subsection (a) shall be ad-
11	ministered in the same manner and under the same
12	terms and conditions as payments made under the
13	heading "Department of Agriculture—Agricultural
14	Programs—Processing, Research and Marketing—
15	Office of the Secretary" in the Extending Govern-
16	ment Funding and Delivering Emergency Assistance
17	Act (Public Law 117–43).
18	(2) Exceptions.—
19	(A) Qualified losses during calendar
20	YEAR 2022.—Payments under subsection (a)
21	shall apply to qualified losses of covered crops
22	occurring in calendar year 2022.
23	(B) PAYMENT LIMITATION.—With respect
24	to payment limitations applied for qualified
25	losses described in subsection (a), the Secretary

1	shall apply separate payment limitations for
2	losses occurring in calendar year 2022.
3	(c) Authorization of Appropriations.—There is
4	authorized to be appropriated to carry out this section
5	such sums as may be necessary.
6	(d) Definitions.—In this section:
7	(1) COVERED CROP.—The term "covered crop"
8	means crops (including milk, on-farm stored com-
9	modities, crops prevented from planting in 2022
10	and harvested adulterated wine grapes), trees
11	bushes, and vines.
12	(2) QUALIFIED LOSS.—The term "qualified
13	loss" means a—
14	(A) loss of a covered crop as a consequence
15	of a drought, wildfire, hurricane, flood, derecho
16	excessive heat, winter storm, freeze (including a
17	polar vortex), smoke exposure, or excessive
18	moisture, as determined by the Secretary; and
19	(B) quality loss of a covered crop, as deter-
20	mined by the Secretary.
21	(3) Secretary.—The term "Secretary" means
22	the Secretary of Agriculture.
