## **3** SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

- 4 This Act may be cited as the "School Resource Offi-
- 5 cers Save Lives Act".

1	SEC. 2. STATE OPIOID RESPONSE GRANTS PROGRAM REAU-
2	THORIZATION; PILOT PROGRAM FOR NARCAN
3	ADMINISTRATION TRAINING.
4	(a) REAUTHORIZATION.—Section 1003(h) of the 21st
5	Century Cures Act (42 U.S.C. 290ee-3 note) is amended
6	by striking "2021" and inserting "2023".
7	(b) Pilot Program for Narcan Administration
8	TRAINING.—Section 1003 of the 21st Century Cures Act
9	(42 U.S.C. 290ee-3 note) is amended—
10	(1) by redesignating subsection $(j)$ as sub-
11	section (k); and
12	(2) by inserting after subsection (i) the fol-
13	lowing:
14	"(j) Pilot Program for Narcan Administration
15	TRAINING.—
16	"(1) IN GENERAL.—As part of the program es-
17	tablished under this section, the Secretary shall es-
18	tablish a pilot program under which the Secretary
19	will award grants to school districts—
20	"(A) to train school resource officers, secu-
21	rity personnel, and school nurses in Narcan ad-
22	ministration; and
23	"(B) to purchase Narcan kits.
24	"(2) PRIORITY.—In selecting recipients of a
25	grant under this subsection, the Secretary shall en-
26	sure that not less than 50 percent of such recipients

1	are school districts located in a rural area (as de-
2	fined by the Secretary).
3	"(3) CONDITIONS.—As a condition on the re-
4	ceipt of a grant under this subsection, the school
5	district shall agree that if the school district has a
6	school resource officer or any security personnel, the
7	officer (or personnel) must be trained in Narcan ad-
8	ministration.
9	"(4) USE OF FUNDS.—A school district selected
10	to receive a grant under this subsection may use
11	funds received through the grant—
12	"(A) to provide training in the administra-
13	tion of Narcan to school resource officers, secu-
14	rity personnel, and school nurses; and
15	"(B) to purchase Narcan kits.
16	"(5) FUNDING.—For each of fiscal years 2022
17	and 2023, the Secretary shall reserve not less than
18	\$5,000,000 of the funds made available under sub-
19	section (h) to carry out the program under this sub-
20	section.".
